Players of all levels will learn vital bidding techniques; but if you have completed a Beginner course, you're ready for this! Topics will include: ♠ Weak 2's and Weak 3's ♠ Overcalls ♠ Weak Jumps ♠ Takeout Doubles ♠ Cue Bids vs. Weak Bids ♠ Negative Doubles ♠ Penalty Doubles.
