Now the time has come to think strategically about how to work with your partner to take the setting tricks. Most defensive planning occurs at Trick 2, with the dummy finally visible. This mini course will make you think and plan, but you'll enjoy using logic and counting to find the winning defense each time. Cost is \$59; register here.

Because so much of your learning takes place while you play, I generally do not record videos of my lessons.
